Creating Sacred Space

What were major discussion points?

Sacred Space is an act of co-creation with man and spirit, manifesting through design. Design is a by-product of your desire to create an experience of healing, and is also a product of our consciousness. Use barriers (architecturally) as a resource. Environments that heal providers result in healing for patients, self, family, and community. It results in increased efficiency, and less illness, increased satisfaction, increased wellbeing, and renewal. Use of color creates additional healing for patients. It begins with a clear intention for what you want for the space.

What did you learn?

Most practical problems of the physical environment are primarily comprised of energetic imbalances; these can be balanced with light, sound, and geometry of the space. Each participant in the group drew a card from the Sacred Geometry Deck, for insights into personal challenges and opportunities.
